

Create

- One or two days per week placement
- Learning through making, developed and delivered by qualified teachers (GCSE, A-Level)
- SENCo approved learning plans, experienced SEMH and pastoral support
- Senior leader liaison with school and multi-agency teams where necessary
- Arts Award Centre for delivery and verification of awards
- Progress tracking with a half-termly comprehensive report
